



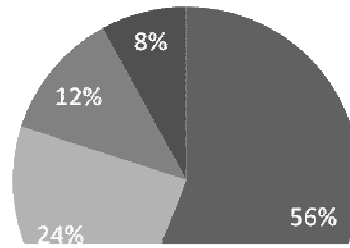
2010 Facts & Demographics

Patient geographic disbursement is as follows:

Suffolk (56%) Isle of Wight (24%)
 Southampton (12%) Franklin (8%)

In 2010, WTFC provided care to 1,237 patients through 9,353 clinic visits.

Since opening in 2007, WTFC has provided care to 1,862 patients through 20,361 clinic visits.



Since beginning the Medication Assistance Program, WTFC has provided more than 12,000 free medications with a retail value of \$5.3 million to over 1,300 patients.

- Patient demographics
 - 75% are between the ages of 44 and 64
 - 60% are women
 - 40% are working full or part-time, many with more than one job
 - 90% of patients are at or below 150% of the federal poverty level (FPL) – for a family of four, this would be an annual income of \$33,075
 - 65% are at or below 100% of the FPL
- Ninety-eight percent (98%) of services are treating and managing chronic illness (hypertension, heart disease, diabetes).
- Potential patients must be qualified to receive services at the Clinic. To meet eligibility requirements, potential patients must:
 - Live in the Western Tidewater Service area
 - Live at or below 200% of the FPL; for a family of four this would be an annual income of \$44,100
 - Have no health insurance
- Volunteers are critical to the successful operation of WTFC. Since opening, volunteers have donated more than 32,000 hours to improve the health and lives of patients. This time has a market value of approximately \$1,200,000.
- Our region’s uninsured rate is 18% (approximately 23,000 individuals).
